1	Calling meeting to order and President's welcome address Having confirmed the quorum by the Asst. Secretary, the meeting was commenced by the President welcoming members to the AGM for the year 2020. It was conducted on virtual basis due to the Covid-19 pandemic. President made a special note that the meeting was commenced in the absence of the Secretary, Mr. T.I. Uduwara since he is under treatment at IDH hospital and wished his early recovery.			
2	Confirmation of the Minutes of the last AGM In absence of the Secretary, the Asst. Secretary read the minutes of the last year which was held on 26 December 2019. The minutes were adopted and proposed by K.M.W and seconded by R.J.			
3	Confirmation of the Financial Report The Treasurer presented the financial report for the aforesaid period. Further, the President informed the meeting that the Financial Report is already submitted to the Auditor General and Ministry of Sports. The Financial Report was adopted and proposed by T.J and seconded by P.C.T.			
4	R.C.T. Activity Report Gobi presented/tabled the activity report for the period of January 01, 2020 – December 31, 2020, which is attached to this minute as an Annexure-I.			
5	Appointment of Hon. President The President informed the House that TEQ Sri Lanka appoints Dr. Janagan Vinayagamoorthy as the Honorary President of TEQ Sri Lanka and it was already confirmed and received an appointment letter from the FITEQ. Following the appointment and accepted by the House, the president presented a short-bio of Dr. VJ. "Dr. Janagan Vinayagamoorthy is appointed as the very first Honorary President of TEQ Sri Lanka by the TEQ Sri Lanka and FITEQ today. Dr. Janagan graduated from the University of Colombo, who now is one of the leading Educationalists in Sri Lanka. He is the Chairman and CEO of IDM Nations Campus and the Founder of Jananam Foundation. Further, he is a Management Consultant, a Professional Accountant, an Entrepreneur and an IT Trainer, who has a wealthy summary of proven track records for a successful career and business", President said. The President further stated "Dr. VJ is a prominent sportsman and sport administrator for more than a decade and gained experience in sport administration at the International level as well."			



Address by the Honorary President

Firstly, Dr. VJ. paid his sincere thanks to both TEQ Sri Lanka and FITEQ on his appointment as very first Honorary President of TEQ Sri Lanka.

Dr. VJ promised to render all his knowledge, experience and skills for the development of Teqball in Sri Lanka. Further, he expressed his gratitude for the TEQ Sri Lanka officials for setting a benchmark through progressing despite the challenges of Covid-19.

Further, he stated that we were able to establish new clubs island wide and conducted many training sessions. We provided the service of Hungarian Coach – Mr. Milan Szabo to our players while keeping mind to produce International Level Teqball players from Sri Lanka and also we were able to obtain service of internationally qualified coaches/referees service to our players. The Hon. President indicated that workshops in Sinhala, Tamil and English medium were held during the period. TEQ Sri Lanka has successfully completed a CSR project in Mannar as well in May 2021.

While expressing his views on future plans he pointed out on conducting education workshops in Tamil and Sinhala medium and organizing club level matches island wide within next few months. Immediate after the club matches prominent players will be selected and conduct special training camps and then select national pool.

He also stated that a strong national team will take part in the upcoming Asian Beach Games in Sanya, China.

New Clubs and Associations

Gobi mentioned that since we were in the budding level in 2020 we were busy in getting recognitions from Ministry of Sports, NOC Sri Lanka as well as from the FITEQ. Also, we were busy in preparing documents and getting Teq tables from FITEQ. Also, the COVID-19 did not allow us to do more as we planned. However, we have established ten clubs in 2020. But, within last four months it has increased to 27 which is remarkably a very good number compared to many other countries. Moreover, 152 athletes have registered on FITEQ platform which indicates that Sri Lanka is in Number Five in the globe based on the total numbers.

Development Plan for 2021

Gobi presented Development Plan for 2021. He explained in detail about the club development plans, courses to be conducted in upcoming weeks for both coaches and referees. Because, TEQ



Sri Lanka believes that we can do fast development through education and using it as a tool we are spreading Teqball around Sri Lanka during this pandemic time. He mentioned that we have already developed 25 plus clubs and will distribute them teq tables sooner the situation is back to normal.

Also, Gobi mentioned that we have arranged to conduct a press conference on April 28, 2021 to highlight multiple activities to the media such as Hon. President Appointment, Website launching, introducing Strategic Partner, and unveiling *"Hon. President Challenge Trophy."* And TEQ Sri Lanka scheduled to conduct Hon. President Challenge Trophy on May 2, 2021 in Torrington grounds. Due to the, COVID-19 pandemic travel restrictions imposed by the government, both events had to be cancelled and put off.

Any other Matters – New Members' Appointment

During the past one year, five of the executive members - Mr. Buddika Iddamalgoda [Vice President], Mr. Prasad Premathilaka [Asst. Secretary], Mr. A. Jayampathi [Committee Member], Mr. Chandana Ekanayake [Committee Member], and Mr. S.B. Senanayake [Committee Member] were not active and failed to appear in the last four Executive Committee Meetings. Therefore, the following members applied for the related posts mentioned below next to their names and the Executive Committee of TEQ Sri Lanka approved it in its last meeting which was held on April 01, 2021.

Since there was no objection, President announced that the appointments were taken as affirmative and ratified by the House, unanimously.

Gobi proposed that we should have at least one-woman member in our Executive Committee. Therefore, Gobi suggested that one of the Committee Members out of three should be a woman and she shall hold the designation of '*Committee Member – Women's Representative*'. It was adopted by the House without any objection.

Mr. Upali Amarathunga said that "I shall provide my fullest support for the development of Teqball at school level."

The Teqball Federation of Sri Lanka (TEQ Sri Lanka) is a governing body for Teqball in Sri Lanka. It was established at its inaugural meeting which was held on 05 December 2018. And its first Annual General Meeting was held on 26 December 2019 at Olympic House, National Olympic Committee of Sri Lanka.



Our vision is '**Teqball for All**' so as to provide an opportunity to everyone in the nation without any discrimination regardless of gender, age, ability, and knowledge level.

Our slogan is '*Proud to be Teqlankan!*' for the promotion and development of Teqball around Sri Lanka.

The TEQ Sri Lanka is established with the following objectives:

 To encourage, promote, develop and control the sports - Teqball in Sri Lanka

- 2. To acquire by all lawful movable and means. immovable property and to apply both capital and income thereof. for or towards all or any of the objectives of the TEQ Sri Lanka
- 3. To formulate and enforce laws governing Teqball in Sri Lanka, and generally to be guided by such definitions as are laid down by the Fédération Internationale de Teqball (FITEQ)
- 4. Generally, to do all such other acts and things as may seem to the TEQ Sri Lanka to be convenient and/or conducive to the carrying out of the objects of the TEQ Sri Lanka.

Our short term goal is to take part in the **Asian Beach Games** to be held in 2021 in Sanya, China.

Moreover, FITEQ sent us only four tables in February - which are highly expensive tables – competition tables. Therefore, the athletes from Prisons Sports Club, Colombo and Mahara Prisons Sports Club were only able to practice until we got the second set of tables

in September 2020.









1. Sri Lanka is on the 5th place in total number of pro athletes' registration with FITEQ.
